1971	First edition of <u>UNIX</u> released 11/03/1971.
1972	Second edition of <u>UNIX</u> released 12/06/1972
1972	Ritchie rewrote B and called the new language C.
1973	Third edition of <u>UNIX</u> released February 1973
1973	Forth edition of <u>UNIX</u> released November 1973
1974	Fifth edition of <u>UNIX</u> released June 1974
1975	Sixth edition of <u>UNIX</u> released May 1975
1975	Bourne shell is introduced begins being added onto.
1977	1 <u>BSD</u> released late 1977
1979	Seventh edition of <u>UNIX</u> released January 1979
1979	<u>SCO</u> founded by Doug and Larry Michels as UNIX porting and consulting company.

1985	Eighth edition of <u>UNIX</u> released February 1985
1985	The GNU manifesto is published in the March 1985 issue
	of Dr. Dobb's Journal. The GNU project starts a year and
	a half later by Richard Stallman.
1986	Ninth edition of <u>UNIX</u> released September 1986
1987	Sun and AT&T lay the groundwork for business
	computing in the next decade with an alliance to develop
	UNIX System V Release 4.
1989	Tenth edition of <u>UNIX</u> released October 1989
1990	AIX short for Advanced Interactive eXecutive was first
	entered into the market by <u>IBM</u> February 1990.
1991	Sun unveils Solaris 2 operating environment, specially
	tuned for symmetric multiprocessing.
1991	<u>Linux</u> is introduced by <u>Linus Trovalds</u> , a student in Finland.
1994	Red Hat Linux is introduced.
1994	Caldera, Inc was founded in 1994 by Ransom Love and
	Bryan Sparks.
1995	SCO acquires UNIX Systems source technology business
	from Novell Corporation (which had acquired it from
	AT&T's UNIX System Laboratories). SCO also acquires
	UnixWare 2 operating system from Novell.
1998	Sun Solaris 7 operating system released.
